LONDON BOROUGH OF EALING CLEAN AIR ACTS, 1956 AND 1968

The Ealing (No. 33) Smoke Control Variation Order

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Ealing in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on 14th July 1970, made an Order entitled "The Ealing (No. 33) Smoke Control Variation Order" which revokes Clause 5 of the Ealing (No. 33) Smoke Control Order and orders that the properties mentioned in that Clause shall be included in and subject to the Ealing (No. 33) Smoke Control Order.

The Ealing (No. 33) Smoke Control Variation Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Ealing (No. 33) Smoke Control Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the 1956 Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building in the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into force before 1st July 1971 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.
