To prohibit the Joading and unloading of vehicles between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in (i) St. Mary's Road from Church Road to Wainwright Grove (ii) Seddon Road and Dock Road from St. Mary's Road for a distance of 30 metres (98'4 feet).
