EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE
COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of the East Riding of Yorkshire (Various Streets, Filey) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1970.

Notice is hereby given that on the 13th August 1970, the County Council of the Administrative County of York, East Riding, made the above-named Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968. The effect of this Order is to prohibit waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. during the period from the 1st May to the 30th September inclusive in each year on the under-mentioned streets and parts of streets at Filey:

- (i) Church Cliff Drive.
- (ii) Extension to Ravine Hill between Church Bridge and Church Cliff Drive.
- (iii) South-east side of Ravine Hill from the junction with the extension referred to in (ii) above in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 20 yards.
- (iv) South side of the unnamed street opposite Crescent Hill between The Crescent and South Crescent Road.
- (v) East side of South Crescent Road from the junction with the unnamed street referred to in (iv) above in a southerly direction to the junction with Southdene.

Exceptions are made in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary to enable persons to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the streets or the services therein.

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on the 24th August 1970, and a map showing the streets and parts of streets to which the Order relates may be inspected at County Hall, Beverley, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on

the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the grounds that any requirement of that section or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with, may within six weeks of the date on which the Order is made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

WEST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNTY
COUNCIL

The County of the West Riding of Yorkshire (Otley Street, Skipton) (Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1970.

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, imposing further waiting restrictions in Otley Street, Skipton.

When this Order comes into effect you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on the northern side of Otley Street, Skipton, from a point 133 feet west of the junction with Rectory Lane to the junction with Court Lane.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) Picking up and setting down passengers.
- (b) Loading or unloading goods.
- (c) Collection or delivery of postal packets by Post Office vehicles.

and, where necessary in connection with:

- (d) A funeral.
- (e) The exercise of Statutory Powers or Duties.
- (f) The maintenance of the roads, and
- (g) The supply of gas, electricity and water.

Full details of the proposal are in the draft Order which together with a map showing the restricted area and a statement of the County Council's reasons
