The City of Leeds (Traffic Regulation) (No. 12) Order 1970

Notice is hereby given that the Leeds City Council in exercise of their powers under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, have made an Order the effect of which will be:

- (a) to prohibit waiting by any vehicle at any time on New York Road from its junction with Regent of the eastern side of Leeds Inner Ring Road North Street Tunnel excluding that portion specified in item (6) (i);
- (b) to prohibit waiting by any vehicle between the hours 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays on the following lengths of road:

- (c) to prohibit the delivery or collection from or loading or unloading of goods between the hours of 8 a.m. to 9.15 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. to 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive or between the hours of 8 a.m. to 9.15 a.m. and 12 noon to 1 p.m. on Saturdays at any premises situate within the following lengths of road;
 - (i) North Street—east side. From its junction with Melbourne Street in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 51 feet;
 - (ii) North Street—west side. From its junction with the entry slip road leading to the east bound carriageway of Leeds Inner Ring Road in a north-easterly direction to a point 51 feet north-east of its junction with Melbourne Street.

The Order will contain certain exemptions for vehicles being used in connection with building or demolition operations and for vehicles being used on certain works by statutory undertakers.

The City of Leeds (Extension to Controlled Zone) (Prohibition of Waiting and One-Way Traffic) (No. 1) Order 1967 and the City of Leeds (Intermediate Zone) Order 1967 will be amended to take account of the proposals.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the lengths of road affected may be inspected between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Mondays to Fridays at the Information Centre, Civic Hall, Leeds, for a period of 6 weeks from the date of this notice.

The Order will come into operation on the 1st day of September 1970.

1. Dewsbury Road

North side. From a point 70 yards west of its junction with the western kerb line of Old Lane
