Tarrant Rushton No. 1 Public Path Diversion Order, 1970

Notice is hereby given that on the 20th August 1970, the Blandford Rural District Council confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order, as confirmed, is to divert the public right of way running from a point east of The Bungalow, Tarrant Rushton, southwards for a distance of 140 yards, turning east for a distance of 90 yards and then southwards for a distance of 100 yards to Rushton Mill, to a line from a point east of The Bungalow, Tarrant Rushton, southwards for a distance of 150 yards, slightly east of the original path turning south-east for a distance of 70 yards to Rushton Mill.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at "Nordon", Salisbury Road, Blandford, Dorset, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.

The Order becomes operative as from the 14th day of September 1970, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act, 1959, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Acts, as amended, or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 7 to the Act, within 6 weeks from the 21st day of September 1970, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
