### PRICES AND INCOMES ACT 1966

#### PROPOSALS BY THE LONDON TRANSPORT EXECUTIVE FOR FARES INCREASES

*Direction under section 5 (4) extending the period within which the National Board for Prices and Incomes must publish their Report.*

Whereas the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity and the Minister of Transport in pursuance of their powers under section 2 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, referred the abovementioned question to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for examination and have published the text of the reference in the *Gazette* on 29th May 1970.

And whereas by section 5 (3) of the Act, but subject to section 5 (4), the Board are required to make their report so as to allow publication within 3 months of the said date.

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity and the Minister of Transport, in pursuance of their powers under the said section 5 (4), hereby direct that the said period of three months be extended by three months.
