#### CITY OF LEEDS

##### CLEAN AIR ACTS 1956 AND 1968

##### *The City of Leeds No. 87 Bramley (Town Street) Smoke Control Order, 1970*

Notice is hereby given that the Lord Mayor, Aldermen and citizens of the City of Leeds acting by the Council for the said City in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Clean Air Acts 1956 (section 11) and 1968, on 22nd July 1970, made an Order entitled *The City of Leeds No. 87 Bramley (Town Street) Smoke Control Order, 1970*, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area which Order is about to be submitted to the Ministry of Housing and Local Government for confirmation. Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the principal Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from the chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity. In addition, in accordance with the Clean Air Act, 1968, section 9 (1) any person who acquires or sells any solid fuel, other than an authorised fuel for use in a building in the smoke control area shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £20.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of August 1971, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government. Copies of the Order and Plan referred to therein may be inspected, free of charge, at the Information Centre, Civic Hall, Leeds 1, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 4th September 1970. Within the said period, any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

#### SCHEDULE

All those lands in the City of Leeds bounded to the north by the southern boundary of Smoke Control Area No. 35 Bramley (Moorside), to the west by the eastern boundaries of Smoke Control Areas No. 74 Bramley (Sandford), No. 19 (Raynville Road), No. 71 Bramley (Wyther), No. 46 Armley (Armley Grange), No. 15 (Poplar), No. 66 Armley (Greenthorpe) and thence by Henconner Lane (part), and Butt Lane (part), to the south by Ring Road Bramley (part), to the east by Swinnow Road (part), Stanningley Road (part), the western boundary of Smoke Control Area No. 67 Stanningley (Westfield) and Broad Lane (part), but excluding the land included in the No. 8 (Gamble Hill) Smoke Control Area, and more particularly delineated on the map hereinbefore referred to.

#### PRESTON COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

##### *The Preston (Area No. 22) Smoke Control Order, 1970*

Notice is hereby given that the Preston County Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, on the 26th day of August 1970, made an Order entitled *The Preston (Area No. 22) Smoke Control Order, 1970*, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine

not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke, and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st June 1971, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Municipal Building, Preston, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 4th September 1970.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

#### SCHEDULE

The area of the County Borough of Preston which lies within a line commencing at the intersection of the centre lines of Gillett Street and Ribblesdale Lane; then proceeding south-westwards along the centre line of Ribblesdale Lane to its intersection with the centre line of Deepdale Road; then northwards along the centre line of Deepdale Road to the point above and opposite the centre line of the Preston—Longridge railway track; then eastwards along the centre line of the track to the point immediately beneath and opposite the centre line of Deepdale Mill Street; then south-eastwards along the centre line of Deepdale Mill Street to its intersection with the centre line of Fletcher Road; then north-eastwards along the centre line of Fletcher Road to its intersection with the centre line of Gillett Street; then south-eastwards along the centre line of Gillett Street to the point of commencement.

## GAS UNDERTAKINGS ACTS

### THE GAS ACT, 1948

#### *The Gas (Declaration of Calorific Value) Regulations, 1949 and*

#### *The Gas (Declaration of Calorific Value) (Amendment) Regulations, 1951*

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the above Act and Regulations that the North Eastern Gas Board propose to alter the declared calorific value of the gas supplied from their Gas Works at Tadcaster in the West Riding of the County of York (at present 500 British Thermal Units per cubic foot) and hereby declare the calorific value of the gas to be supplied from such Gas Works as 1,000 British Thermal Units per cubic foot.

### TELEX CHARGES NOTICE

These charges have been fixed by the Post Office in accordance with regulation 2 (2) of the Telex Regulations 1965 (in force as a scheme under the Post Office Act 1969) and may be revised at any time by the Post Office.

6s. 0d. for the first 3 minutes (or part thereof); and

2s. 0d. for each subsequent minute (or part thereof).

*Calls obtained without the assistance of an operator*

2½d. for each 6 seconds (or part thereof).

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
