

TELEX CHARGES NOTICE

INTERNATIONAL PHOTOTELEGRAPH SERVICE

The Post Office hereby gives notice pursuant to regulations 8 (2) and 33 (7) of the Telegraph (British Commonwealth and Foreign Written Telegram) Regulations 1959 and regulation 6 (2) of the Telegraph (British Commonwealth and Foreign Written Press Telegram) Regulations 1959 (which have effect under paragraph 3 (1) of Schedule 9 to the Post Office Act 1969 as if they were provisions of a scheme made under section 28 of that Act) that a public phototelegraph service will become available from the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man to Tanzania on 1st September 1970 and the charges on and from 1st September 1970 for phototelegrams from the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man to Tanzania will be as shown below.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

ALTRINCHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Altrincham Corporation (Various Roads, Timperley Village) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1970.

Notice is hereby given that the Altrincham Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to:

1. Prohibit waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the length and sides of lengths of road shown in Schedule I.
2. Prohibit waiting by vehicles at any time on the lengths of road shown in Schedule II.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to permit waiting for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading and for funerals, building and road works and the maintenance of essential services.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the lengths and the sides of lengths of road to which the proposed Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the undersigned during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposals together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in

writing to the undersigned by the 27th September 1970.

SCHEDULE I

*Length and sides of lengths of road in the Borough of Altrincham*1. *Thorley Lane*

The east side from its junction with Stockport Road for a distance of 205 feet in a southerly direction.

The west side from its junction with Stockport Road for a distance of 246 feet in a southerly direction.

2. *Mayfield Road*

The east side from its junction with Stockport Road for a distance of 154 feet in a southerly direction.

The west side from its junction with Stockport Road for a distance of 75 feet in a southerly direction.

3. *Bedford Drive*

The east side from its junction with Stockport Road for a distance of 200 feet in a southerly direction.

The west side from its junction with Stockport Road for a distance of 210 feet in a southerly direction.

4. *Stockport Road*

The south side from a point 79 feet west of its junction with Thorley Lane for a distance of 683 feet in an easterly direction.

The north side from its junction with Bloomsbury Lane for a distance of 984 feet in an easterly direction.

5. *Orchard Place*

From its junction with Stockport Road for a distance of 140 feet in a northerly direction.

SCHEDULE II

*Lengths of road in the Borough of Altrincham*1. *Grove Lane*

From its junction with Stockport Road for a distance of 526 feet in a westerly direction.

2. *Park Road*

From its junction with Stockport Road to its junction with Grange Road. (288)
