Exceptions will be made in the Order to enable loading and unloading of vehicles to take place; to enable vehicles to take on board or set down passen-gers and to enable services to be laid and maintained.

## FIRST SCHEDULE

No Waiting-8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays Butter Hill and Rotunda. Along the south-east side from the junction with Rose Hill to the north-west corner of Butter Hill House garden.

  (a) the north side, between a point 220 feet east of its junction with North Street and a point 75 feet west of the Cattle Market; between a point 65 feet west of its junction with Mill Lane to a point on the west boun-dary of the frontage of High Street Car Park; and from a point 15 feet east of its junction with Wathen Road to a point opposite the west side of its junction with Moores Road.
  (b) the south side between a point 210 feet east of its junction with South Street and a point 16 feet east of its junction with Lyons court; between points 36 feet and 44 feet east of its junction with Lyons Court; from a point 84 feet east of its junction with Lyons Court to a point 90 feet west of its junction with Dene Street; and between a point 15 feet west of its junction with Dene Street and the west side of its junction with Moores Road. Horsham Road. The east side between a point 55 feet on the north-castern side of the northern boundary of the Queen's Head Public House and a point 105 feet north from the north side of its junction with St. Paul's Road; and between a point

Dene Street. Both sides between the northern end of the official street parking place and a point 100 feet south of the south side of its junction with Marlborough Road.

Rose Hill. Both sides from its junction with South Street eastwards to its junction with Peacock Walk.

Access Road between Service Road and South Street Car Park. Both sides from its junction with South Street eastwards for a distance of 100 feet. Marlborough Road

- (a) the south-east side between its junction with Dene Street and the south-east side of its junction with Beresford Road.
- (b) the north west side from its junction with Dene Street south westwards for a distance of 60 feet and from a point 140 feet southwest of Dene Street for a distance of 120 feet.
- (c) the north-east and north-west sides from Back Alley to a point 390 feet south-west of Dene Street.
- (d) the south-west side from Back Alley southeastwards for a distance of 140 feet and from a point 200 feet south-east of Back Alley south-eastwards for a distance of 90 feet.
- (e) the south-west and north-west sides from a point 400 feet south-east of Back Alley to a point opposite the south-east side of its junction with Beresford Road.
- (f) both sides from the south-west boundary of No. 57 Marlborough Road to the north-east boundary of No. 60 Marlborough Road.
