(x) provide that parking tokens may be purchased from the Council for the sum of 2s. 6d. each for use in connection with Parking Calendars; (xi) provide that an excess charge of £1 shall be incurred in respect of any vehicle left in a parking place named in the First and Second Schedules for longer than the initial period for which payment was made by the initial charge and that payment of any excess charge incurred shall be made to the Council by the seventh day following the day on which the excess charge following the day on which the excess charge was incurred and that the period for which a vehicle may be left in such a parking place, during the permitted hours after the excess charge has been incurred shall not exceed two

(xii) provide for the surrender or withdrawal of season tickets in certain prescribed events and for the refund of fees paid therefor in respect of complete months only in accordance with a

(xiii) provide for the refund of the cost of unused residents' parking tokens upon the Council being satisfied that they have not at any time been affixed either wholly or in part to a parking

calendar;
(xiv) provide for the use without payment of any
unexpired time indicated on a parking meter
installed in a parking bay in a parking place
named in the First and Second Schedules insofar as the maximum initial periods referred to in
paragraphs (vi) and (vii) cannot be exceeded;
(xv) prescribe the manner in which vehicles shall
stand in parking places:

(xvi) provide that a traffic warden may remove or cause to be removed from a parking place any vehicle in respect of which certain provisions of the Order have been contravened or not complied with;

(xvii) empower the Council to install parking meters at parking places;
(xviii) provide that disabled persons who have been notified in writing by the Council may park in a parking bay or parking space free of charge and without time limit;
(xiv) provide that the qualifying residents of the
