## COLCHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Colchester (East Street)  
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1970*

Notice is hereby given that the Colchester Borough Council have made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in East Street.

## COLCHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Colchester (Harwich Road, Bromley Road and Hawthorn Avenue) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1970.*

Notice is hereby given that the Colchester Borough Council have made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in the following lengths of roads between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive:

*Hawthorn Avenue*, from its junction with Bromley Road to a point 40 feet north of the junction with Solway Court.

*Pine Tree Court*, for a distance of 45 feet from its junction with Hawthorn Avenue.

*Bromley Road*, from its junction with Harwich Road to a point 325 feet east of its junction with Hawthorn Avenue.

*Linden Close*, for a distance of 45 feet from its junction with Bromley Road.

*Harwich Road*, from a point 360 feet south of its junction with Churnwood Road for a distance of 650 feet in a southerly and westerly direction from that point.

*The Borough of Colchester (Moorside)  
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1970*

Notice is hereby given that the Colchester Borough Council have made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in the following lengths of roads:

*Moorside*, from its junction with East Street to a point 45 feet south of the road junction on the east side of Moorside at the rear of No. 44 East Street.

Road off the east side of Moorside at the rear of No. 44 East Street for a distance of 45 feet from its junction with Moorside.

## COLCHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Colchester (Greenstead Road and Hythe Station Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1970.*

Notice is hereby given that the Colchester Borough Council have made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in the following lengths of road between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive:

*Greenstead Road*, between a point 15 feet east of the junction with the eastern side of Greenstead Court and a point 150 feet east of the junction with the eastern side of public footpath No. 117.

*Hythe Station Road*, between its junction with Greenstead Road and its junction with the railway level crossing.

## DARWEN BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Darwen (Charles Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1970*

Notice is hereby given that the Darwen Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on both sides of Charles Street from its junction with Duckworth Street in a north-easterly direction to a point east of the Fire Station Appliance Room doors, a distance of 57 yards.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers,
- (b) loading or unloading goods, and where necessary, in connection with:
  - (i) the improvement of the length of road, or of the services therein;
  - (ii) to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties.
