TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS 1962 AND 1968

Mineral Workings Act 1951

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 153 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1962 and section 32 of the Mineral Workings Act 1951 entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (County of Northumberland) (No. 2) Order 1970" authorising the temporary stopping up for a period of five years of unclassified road 8108, Whittonstall, Northumberland, to enable development consisting of opencast coal mining to be carried out by the National Coal Board, the stopped up highway to be restored at the end of the period.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS 1962 AND 1968

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 153 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1962 entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (City and County of Newcastle upon Tyne) (No. 7) Order 1970" authorising the stopping up of lengths and parts of Foster Street, part of Mitchell Street, and lengths of the footpath of and adjoining Foster Street, Back Bath Street East, Back Mitchell Street South and the footpath adjoining Back Mitchell Street South, Newcastle upon Tyne.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS 1962 AND 1968
