WARLEY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

Roads in the County Borough of Warley

Column 1

Column 2

Hill Top Road. *North-east side*—from a point on the kerb edge opposite the boundary between No. 1 Hill Top Road and No. 146 George Road for a distance of approximately 167 yards in a north-westerly direction to a point on the kerb edge opposite the boundary fencing between Nos. 47 and 49 Hill Top Road.

South-west side—from its junction with George Road for a distance of approximately 140 yards to a point opposite the boundary fencing between Nos. 47 and 49 Hill Top Road.

George Road. *North-east side*—from its junction with Hill Top Road to a point approximately 33 yards north-west of that junction.

South-west side—from a point approximately 33 yards north-west of its junction with Hill Top Road for approximately 117 yards in a south-easterly direction to a point at the junction of George Road and Bleakhouse Road approximately 50 yards north-east of a point on the kerb edge opposite the boundary fencing between Nos. 26 and 28 Bleakhouse Road.

The Borough of Watford (Kytes Drive) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1971

Notice is hereby given that the Watford Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968.

When this Order comes into effect you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time on the length and sides and length of road as follows:

Coates Way the north side, for a distance of 10 metres on either side of its junction with Kytes Drive.

Kytes Drive both sides, for a distance of 10 metres from its junction with Coates Way.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of (a) picking up or setting down passengers, (b) loading or unloading goods, or (c) carrying out essential services connected with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water and electricity.

The Borough of Watford (Cassiobridge Road) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1971

WATFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Watford (Douglas Avenue) (Weight Restriction) Order 1971

Notice is hereby given that the Watford Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968.

The effect of this Order will be to prohibit the use of Douglas Avenue, Hillrise Avenue and Tudor Drive by any vehicle exceeding 3 tons in weight, whether laden or unladen, unless the vehicle is being used for the conveyance of persons or goods to or from any premises situated in any of those roads. Further exceptions in the Order will include vehicles used in connection with certain building, reconstruction or maintenance works, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.
