*The Guildford Rural District Council (Footpath No. 149 Shere) Public Path Diversion Order, 1970*

Notice is hereby given that on the 26th day of November 1970, the Guildford Rural District Council confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order, as confirmed, is to divert the public right of way running across land adjoining the property known as The Millstones, Sandy Lane, Shere, Surrey, to a line running across the said land which line is 4 feet to the west of the western boundary of the said property known as The Millstones.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the Council Offices, Millmead House, Guildford, Surrey, and may be inspected free of charge at the said Council Offices between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

This Order becomes operative as from the 18th day of December 1970, but if any person aggrieved by the Order decides to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1968, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any Regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he may under section 178 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, within 6 weeks from the 18th day of December 1970, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

*Sandbach Urban District Council (Middlewich Road—School Lane) Public Path (Diversion) Order, 1970.*

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") made on the 16th day of November 1970, is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation or to be confirmed by the

Sandbach Urban District Council as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert that part of the public right of way running from Middlewich Road to School Lane which commences at its junction with Middlewich Road and proceeds in a south-westerly and westerly direction for a distance of approximately 65 yards; to a line running from Middlewich Road at a point 27 yards in a north-westerly direction from the junction of the original footpath with Middlewich Road and proceeds in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 45 yards where it rejoins the original footpath.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it may be inspected free of charge at the offices of the Sandbach Urban District Council, Council Offices, Crewe Road, Sandbach, between the usual office hours on Mondays to Fridays.

Any representation or objection with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the Clerk of the Sandbach Urban District Council, not later than the 11th January 1971, and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Sandbach Urban District Council may, instead of submitting the Order to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation, themselves confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted to the Minister for confirmation any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent to the Minister with the Order.

 Public Footpath No. 79 Public Path Stopping-up

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") made on the 17th day of November 1970, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to extinguish the public right of way running from a point 200 feet approximately north-east of High Street, Skelmersdale (at its junction with footpath No. 74 which commences at High Street) for a distance of 360 feet approximately in a north-easterly direction generally, then in an easterly direction for a distance of 165 feet approximately to a point 200 feet approximately west of Church Road, Skelmersdale.

A copy of the Order and map contained therein has been deposited at the Municipal Buildings, Hall Green, Up Holland and may be inspected free of charge at the Municipal Buildings between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on weekdays (except Saturdays).

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Skelmersdale and Holland Urban District Council may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, themselves confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for confirmation any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent to the Secretary of State with the Order.
