(xi) provide that the period for which a vehicle may be left in a parking place referred to in Part I or Part II of the first Schedule hereto after the excess charge has been incurred shall

not exceed one hour;

(xii) provide that the charge in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place described in Part III of the first Schedule hereto shall be payable either by the issue of a parking token and by affixing in the manner prescribed in the Order that parking token to the parking card relating to that vehicle not later than on the leaving of the vehicle in such a parking place, or by the purchase of a season ticket.
(xiii) prescribe the manner in which vehicles shall stand in parking places;
(xiv) empower the Council to install parking meters at parking places; (xii) provide that the charge in respect of a vehicle
