

## BRIDGWATER BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Bridgwater (Various Streets) (Prohibition and Limitation of Waiting) (Amendment) (No. 13) Order, 1970.*

Notice is hereby given that Bridgwater Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be:

- (a) to prohibit waiting at any time on any day other than a Sunday on the east side of Taunton Road from its junction with Broadway to its junction with St. Mary Street.
- (b) to prohibit waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday around the traffic island in St. John Street between Nos. 148 and 169 St. John Street.

The usual exemptions will apply.

Copies of the proposed Order and map showing the proposed restrictions may be inspected at my office during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposals together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 31st December 1970.

## BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Buckinghamshire County Council (Traffic Regulation) (Lane End) Order, 1970*

Notice is hereby given that the Buckinghamshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in lengths of the Stokenchurch to Marlow Road, B.482 (both sides), Frieth Road (both sides) and Sands Road (both sides of road—both arms), Lane End.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic or the maintenance of the road or the services therein in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, or to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of road.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map indicating the lengths of road affected, together with a statement of the reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected during normal office hours at the County Hall, Aylesbury, and at the offices of the Wycombe Rural District Council, Bellfield House, 80 Oxford Road, High Wycombe, during the period 14th December 1970 to 4th January 1971.

Any objection to the proposals, together with the grounds on which it is made, must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 4th January 1971.

## DERBY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Derby Corporation (Sadler Gate) (Experimental Prohibition of Driving) Order 1970*

Notice is hereby given that on the 2nd December 1970 the Derby County Borough Council made an Order under section 9 (1), (2), (3) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to prohibit vehicles from being driven in that part of Sadler Gate between a point 135 feet west of its junction with Iron Gate and a point 60 feet east of its junction with the Strand between the hours of 10.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. each day.

The Order will come into operation on the 3rd January 1970, a copy of the Order and a map showing the road concerned may be inspected at the Town Clerk's Office, The Council House, Derby, between the hours of 8.45 a.m. and 12.50 p.m. and 2 p.m. and 5.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays.

Any person who desires to question the validity of this Order on any ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, or that any requirement of those sections or any regulations made under the said Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the 8th December 1970, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

## DERBY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Derby Corporation (Central Area Waiting Restrictions) (Amendment) Order 19*

Notice is hereby given that the Derby County Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

The effect of the Order will be:

1. To prohibit the loading and unloading of goods from vehicles between 8.30 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and 4.45 p.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays in:

*Full Street.* From its junction with Cathedral Road and its junction with Derwent Street (but not including the western carriageway).

*Albert Street.*

*Cheapside.*

*Strand.*

*Bold Lane.*

*Jury Street.*

*Walker Lane.* From its junction with Jury Street and its junction with Cathedral Road.

*Tenant Street.*

*St. James's Street.*

2. To limit waiting to 30 minutes in any hour between 9.15 a.m. and 4.45 p.m. in:

*Cheapside.*

*Bold Lane.*

*Queen Street.*

3. To limit waiting to 2 hours in any 3 hours between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. in Cathedral Road.

4. To limit waiting to 1 hour in any 2 hours between 9.15 a.m. and 4.45 p.m. on the west side of Full Street from No. 36 Full Street northwards for a distance of 120 feet.

5. To prohibit waiting at all times in:

*Albert Street.*

*Market Place.* South side.

Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order which together with a map showing the roads to which the proposals relate and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the Town Clerk's Office, The Council House, Corporation Street, Derby, between 8.45 a.m. and 12.50 p.m. and 2 p.m. and 5.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays.
