

The effect of the Order which will come into operation on 14th December 1970, is to prohibit any person from causing a vehicle (except maintenance vehicles engaged on duties in Poole Park) to be driven along the unnamed park road in a north-easterly direction beyond the access road to the Swan Lake Cafe car park.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the length of road affected are available at the Municipal Buildings, Civic Centre, Poole where they may be examined during normal business hours Mondays to Fridays.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or any grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from 8th December 1970, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

#### POOLE BOROUGH COUNCIL

##### *Poole (Nuffield Road) (One Way Traffic)* *(Amendment No. 1) Order 1970*

Notice is hereby given that on 8th December 1970 Poole Borough Council made the above-named Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

The effect of the proposed Order which comes into operation on 10th December 1970 is to amend the Poole (Nuffield Road) (One Way Traffic) Order 1969:

- (a) to prohibit persons driving any vehicles on the length of road specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto in any direction other than that specified in column 2 of the said Schedule;
- (b) to revoke the existing restriction prohibiting persons driving any vehicles on the length of road specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto in any direction other than that specified in column 2 of the said Schedule.

#### ROTHERHAM COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

##### *The County Borough of Rotherham (Drummond Street and Wharnccliffe Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1971.*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Rotherham propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in Drummond Street and Wharnccliffe Street, Rotherham, and also to prohibit the loading of goods on to or unloading of goods from vehicles between the hours of 7 a.m. and 10 a.m. and between the hours of 1 p.m. and 6 p.m. on part of Drummond Street.

- (b) loading or unloading goods (subject to the prohibition of loading or unloading goods between certain hours on part of Drummond Street referred to above);
- (c) collecting or delivering postal packets for the Post Office;
- (d) the maintenance of the roads and the services therein.

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the restricted roads and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the Borough Solicitor's Department, Municipal Offices, Howard Street Rotherham, on weekdays (except Saturdays), between 9 a.m. and 12.45 p.m. and 2.15 p.m. and 5.15 p.m.
