## State Intelligence

### TREASURY

Treasury Chambers, London S.W.1.

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby given notice that they have made an Order under section 5 of the Import Duties Act 1958, Viz.:

The Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 11) Order 1970 No. 1819.

This Order provides that the goods listed in Schedule 1 shall be exempt or shall continue to be exempt, from import duty until 1st January 1972, except for items for which an earlier day is specified. Descriptions of goods which were not exempt at the date of this Order are marked\*.

Some goods, the exemption of which is continued by this Order, appear under a modified description. These items are marked †.

Two items viz. "Methyl  $\alpha$ -Dxyloside and Methyl  $\beta$ -D-xyloside" which were previously classified in 29.43 are now re-classified in 29.10 following a Classification Opinion of the Customs Co-operation Council and are marked ††.

The Order also continues until 1st July 1971, the partial exemption for photographic film base of cellulose acetate.

The Import Duties (Temporary Reductions) Order 1970.

This Order reduces the import duty on unsweetened canned pears from 15 per cent. to 5 per cent. ad valorem for a period of 6 months.

The Order comes into operation on 1st January 1971 and has been published as Statutory Instrument 1970 No. 1817.
