#### A PROCLAMATION

REVOKING A PROCLAMATION, DATED THE 12TH DAY OF DECEMBER 1970, DECLARING THE EXISTENCE OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY

Whereas by Our Proclamation, dated the twelfth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and seventy, We declared that a state of emergency existed within the meaning of the Emergency Powers Act 1920, as amended by the Emergency Powers Act 1964:

And whereas it appears to Us that the state of emergency has now ceased to exist and that it is expedient that the said Proclamation should be revoked accordingly.

Now, therefore, We do, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, hereby proclaim that the said Proclamation is revoked.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace this seventeenth day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy, and in the nineteenth year of Our Reign.
