Pay of the Armed Forces On 2nd November 1967, in pursuance of their powers under section 3(2) of the Prices and Incomes Act, 1966, the Secretary of State for Economic Affairs, the Chancellor of the Exchequer and the Secretary of State for Defence, acting jointly, instructed the National Board for Prices and Incomes to keep under continuous review the pay and allowances of mem-bers of naval, military or air forces of the Crown and of any women's service administered by the Defence Council. Council.

The Board has now made its fourth report, and in accordance with section 5(1) of the Act, the Prime Minister and Minister for the Civil Service, the Chancellor of the Exchequer, the Secretary of State for Defence and the Secretary of State for Employment hereby give notice that this report, entitled "The Pay of Senior Officers" was first published as Command Paper Number 4513 on 8th December 1970.
