

PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL

The Portsmouth (Victoria Road North/Victoria Road South (Restrictions on Waiting) (No. 12) Order 1970

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

When this Order comes into effect you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time on the greater part of Victoria Road North, between its junction with Carlisle Road and Elm Grove. Waiting will be permitted for one hour in any period of two hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays on the east side of this road outside Nos. 46-50 Victoria Road North but where the road is sufficiently wide to enable parking on one side, restrictions are proposed on one side only.

It is also proposed to prohibit waiting at any time on the east side of Victoria Road South near its junction with Hereford Road and in the following roads, which have junctions with either Victoria Road North or Victoria Road South, for a short length on both sides from the junction—

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading or unloading goods and to enable vehicles used by registered Medical Practitioners to wait while they are engaged upon their professional duties.

PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL

The Portsmouth (London Road) (Restrictions on Waiting) (No. 11) Order 1970

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

When this Order comes into effect you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time on the greater part of London Road, Hilsea between its junctions with Oakwood Road and Connaught Road. In other parts of this road waiting will be permitted for one hour in any period of two hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. (Mondays to Saturdays) but waiting restrictions are not proposed where the road is sufficiently wide to permit parking on one side.

It is also proposed to prohibit waiting at any time in the following roads which have junctions with this section of London Road for a short length on both sides from the junction:

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading or unloading goods and to enable vehicles used by registered Medical Practitioners to wait while they are engaged upon their professional duties.

SALOP COUNTY COUNCIL

The Salop County Council (Hadley Park Road, Hadley) (Prohibition of Waiting and Prohibition of Loading and Unloading) Order

Notice is hereby given that the Salop County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

When this Order comes into effect, you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle between the hours of 7 a.m. and 9 a.m., 12 noon and 2 p.m. or 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in that length of Hadley Park Road which extends from its junction with the Wellington—Newport Road (A.518) at Hadley to a point 150 yards south-east of its junction with the Leegomery—Horton Road. The proposal includes a prohibition on the loading and unloading of goods during the same periods.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (i) picking up and setting down passengers and, where necessary, in connection with;
- (ii) the maintenance of the road; and
- (iii) the supply of gas, water and electricity.

Full details of this proposal are in the draft Order, which, together with a map showing the length of road concerned and a statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 12.30 p.m. and 2.30 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays at The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury, and at the Wellington Rural District Council Offices, Tan Bank, Wellington.

SWANSEA CITY COUNCIL

The City of Swansea (Mumbles Road, Oystermouth) (Prohibition of waiting) Order 1970

Notice is hereby given that on the 16th day of December 1970, the Council of the City of Swansea made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which is to forbid any vehicle to wait in the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

The Order will come into operation on the 21st day of December 1970.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the roads to which the Order relates may be inspected at the Town Clerk's Department, The Guildhall, Swansea, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the
