ROCHDALE COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Rochdale (Urban Clearway) (No. 1) Order 1970

Notice is hereby given that on 17th December 1970 the Rochdale County Borough Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit, in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice, the waiting of vehicles at all times.

The Order contains exemptions to allow vehicles to wait for a period not exceeding two minutes to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with

any building operation or demolition or in connection with any statutory undertaking or any statutory duty or power or in connection with the removal of furniture.
