The Urban District of Longbenton (Salters Bridge and Dentsmires Bridge) Weight Restrictions Order 1970.

Notice is hereby given that the Urban District Councils of Gosforth and Longbenton, on the 27th January 1971, and the 10th February 1971 respectively, made Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by the Transport Act, 1968 the effect of which will be to impose a weight restriction of three tons and over on vehicles using the Salters Bridge and the Dentsmires Bridge. The Orders will come into operation on the 15th February 1971.

Copies of the Orders and a map showing the bridges to which the Orders relate may be inspected at the Council Chamber, High Street, Gosforth and at the Council Offices, Forest Hall, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under them have not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Gosforth No. 1 (Fawdon Red House Farm Estate) Smoke Control Order 1971

Notice is hereby given that the Gosforth Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956 on the 27th January 1971 made an Order entitled the Gosforth No. 1 (Fawdon Red House Farm Estate) Smoke Control Order, 1971 declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable
