

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Gloucestershire County Council (Aust and Olveston) (Weight Restriction) (Variation) Order 1971

Notice is hereby given that on 5th April 1971 the Gloucestershire County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which is to extend that length of the Almondsbury—Aust Road (B.4461) which is subject to a weight restriction of 3 tons so as to prohibit any person from causing any motor vehicle the unladen weight of which exceeds 3 tons to proceed in the length of road specified in the Schedule. Alternative routes for such vehicles are available.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to permit the driving on the said length of road of any vehicle which is being used:

- (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent thereto;
- (b) for the purpose of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to such roads or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land;
- (c) for the purpose of refuse collection by the Thornbury R.D.C.
- (d) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance etc., of that length of road or the services therein.
- (e) a public service vehicle while being used as a stage carriage.

A copy of the Order which comes into operation on 13th April 1971, together with the relevant map, may be inspected at all reasonable hours at Room 213, Shire Hall, Gloucester and Thornbury R.D.C. Offices, Stokefield House, Thornbury.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Aust and Olveston Parishes—Thornbury R.D.

That length of the Almondsbury—Aust Road (B.4461) in the Parishes of Olveston and Aust which extends from its junction with Hardy Lane (3/240) at Tockington in a general north-westerly direction to the south-east side of its junction with Priestpool Lane (unclassified).
