WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

Made-up Textiles Wages Council (Great Britain)

The Made-up Textiles Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Secretary of State for Employment proposals for (1) increasing the statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Made-up Textiles) Order 1970 (Order M.T.(66)); and (2) the revocation of Order M.T. TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS 1962 AND 1968

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1968, to authorise the stopping up of a length of the A.259 Brighton Road, a length of Dolphin Hard (Ruapp 3156), a length of the footbridge that crosses Coronation Green, a length of Stows Hard (Ruapp 3157), a length of Tarmount Hard (Ruapp 3158), a length of Surrey Street, a length of new road, two lengths of Ham Road, a length of Albion Cottages, a length of Eastern Avenue, a length of Kingston Lane, two lengths of Victoria Road and a length of Grange Road, in the interests of the safety of users and to facilitate the movement of traffic on the highway to be constructed and improved between the Saltings Roundabout, Shoreham and Grange Road, Southwick. The relevant development is the subject of an application for planning permission and that application stands referred to the Secretary of State in pursuance of a direction under section 22 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1962.

The proposed Order will require the provision of new highways maintainable at the public expense, for which the highway authority is to be the West Sussex County Council, and the improvement of existing highways.

During 28 days from the 7th May 1971 copies of the draft Order and relevant plans may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the West Sussex County Council Offices, County Hall, Chichester, Sussex and may be obtained free of charge from the Department of the Environment (quoting reference DSE 500/35/1/L/03) at the address stated below.

Within the above-mentioned period of 28 days any person may by notice to the Secretary of State (reference DSE 500/35/1/L/03) object to the making of the Order.

In the event of objections to the Order being received a Public Inquiry will be held on 28th June 1971 at St. Mary's Hall, 25 East Street, Shoreham by Sea, Sussex at 10.30 a.m.

This notice supersedes that published on 23rd April 1971.
