

ST. HELENS COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL
The St. Helens (Claughton Street Access Road)
Traffic Order 1971

Notice is hereby given that the St. Helens County Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on any day in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The Order contains the usual exemptions for boarding and alighting from vehicles, loading and unloading goods, and permitting Post Office vehicles and vehicles used in the pursuance of statutory powers and duties.

A copy of the proposed Order and map showing the length of road affected and of the statement

of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be seen at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, St. Helens at all reasonable hours.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 10th July 1971, and must specify the grounds on which the objections are based.

STAFFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Stafford (Britannia Street, Leek)
One-Way Traffic Order 1971

Notice is hereby given that on the 15th June 1971 the Staffordshire County Council made the above-named Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to prohibit the driving of any vehicle along Britannia Street, Leek, between Chorley Street and Picton Street, other than in a westerly direction, i.e., towards Picton Street.

The Order will come into operation on 28th June 1971.
