PART I

Description of site of existing paths or ways

The highway to be diverted is in the Parish of Llanillterne in the Rural District of Cardiff in the County of Glamorgan, namely:

A length of Bridleway No. 2 from a point approximately 30 yards (25 m.) or thereabouts from the north-western edge of Graig-y-Parc Wood in a northerly direction to its termination on Graig-y-Parc Road, a distance of 70 yards (65 m.) or thereabouts, shown in a bold black line between the points A-B on the deposited plan.

PART II

Description of site of Alternative Highways

The new highways to be provided by the developer shall be:

A bridleway, 8 feet wide, from a point approximately 30 yards (25 m.) or thereabouts from the north-western edge of Graig-y-Parc Wood in a north-westerly direction to its termination at Heol Pantygored, a distance of 40 yards (35 m.) or thereabouts, shown in a broken black line between the points B-C on the deposited plan.

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1968

SECTION 94

The Herefordshire County Council (Fownhope) Public Path Diversion Order, 1971

Notice is hereby given that on the 9th June 1971 the Herefordshire County Council confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to:

(a) divert a length of the public right of way (FWA.11) in the Parish of Fownhope running in a northerly direction from its junction with the Hereford-Mitcheldean Road B.4224;

(b) divert a length of the public right of way (FWA.11A) running in a generally westerly direction from its junction with the Fownhope-Common Hill road (UC.632);

(c) divert the public right of way (FWA.10G) running in a north-easterly direction from its junction with the public right of way (FWA.11) above referred to, and the continuing length of the public right of way (FWA.10B) to its junction with the public right of way (FWA.10).
