A PROCLAMATION

ALTERING THE DAY APPOINTED FOR THE AUGUST BANK HOLIDAY IN ENGLAND AND WALES IN THE YEAR 1971

ELIZABETH R.

Whereas We consider it inexpedient that the first Monday in August should be a bank holiday in England and Wales in the year 1971:

Now, therefore, We, in exercise of the powers conferred on Us by section 5 of the Bank Holidays Act 1971, section 3 of the Holidays Extension Act 1875 and section 3(3) of the Customs and Excise Act 1952, do hereby, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, declare and appoint that in England and Wales in the year 1971 the first Monday in August shall not be a bank holiday, a public holiday in the Inland Revenue Offices or a holiday in the Customs and Excise, and instead the thirtieth day of August shall be a bank holiday, a public holiday in the Inland Revenue Offices and a holiday in the Customs and Excise.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace, this twenty-third day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-one, and in the twentieth year of Our Reign.
