Notice is hereby given that on the 1st July 1971, the Council of the County Borough of Darlington made the above-mentioned Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968.

The Order, which prohibits waiting in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule below will come into operation on Monday, 2nd August 1971.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the area affected may be inspected at the Town Hall, Darlington, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., Mondays to Fridays.

2. Trinity Road ...	The North side from the junction with Cleveland Avenue to the West side of the junction with Vane Terrace. The South side for a distance of 4 yards eastwards from the junction with Cleveland Avenue.
3. Abbey Road ...	The North side for a distance of 15 yards East and West of the junction with Cleveland Avenue.
