This order, which came into operation on 15th July 1971, amends the Equine Animals (Importation) Order 1969 by providing that equine animals from countries outside Europe (other than countries from which importation is altogether forbidden by the principal order) can no longer be imported into

Great Britain without restriction if accompanied by an appropriate veterinary certificate but must now have their importation authorised by a licence issued by the Minister.
