Notice is hereby given that the Monmouthshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times in Llanarth Square, Pontymister in the Urban District of Risca.

NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Northampton (Station Road, Earls Barton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1971

Notice is hereby given that the Northamptonshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting on the eastern side of Station Road, Earls Barton, from a point 65 yards south of its junction with The Square for 110 yards in a southerly direction.

PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL

The Portsmouth (Queen Street) (Restrictions on Waiting) (No. 20) Order 1971

Notice is hereby given that on the 3rd August 1971 the Portsmouth City Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

This Order comes into effect on 1st September 1971 and means that you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time on the greater part of Queen Street. In one part of this road, on the south side from a point 30 feet east of its junction with Hanover Street, waiting will be prohibited for a distance of approximately 120 feet between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., Monday to Saturday. In other parts of this road waiting will be permitted for 1 hour in any period of 2 hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. (Mondays to Saturdays).
