MEDICINES ACT 1968

Addendum 1971 to the British Pharmacopoeia 1968
The Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health in England and in Wales, the Secretary of State concerned with health in Scotland, the Minister of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, having on the recommendation of the Medicines Commission caused to be published the Addendum 1971 to the British Pharmacopoeia, and the Amendments to that Addendum set out in the Schedule to this notice, hereby give notice in compliance with section 102 of the Medicines Act 1968 that this Addendum and its Amendments shall take effect on 1st October 1971.

William Clowes and Sons Limited, London, Beccles and Colchester, have been authorised by the Ministers to print copies of the subject-matter contained in the above Addendum to the British Pharmacopoeia 1968 and the Amendments to that Addendum as set out below.
