EXTINGUISHMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

South Cambridgeshire Rural District— Morden Heath, Steeple Morden, Cambridgeshire

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 153 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, has made an Order entitled "The South Cambridgeshire Rural District Council (Footpaths Nos. 42 and 43) (Parish of Steeple Morden) Public Path Stopping Up Order 1971".

The effect of the Order will be to stop up the parts of footpaths Nos. 42 and 43 at Morden Heath, Steeple Morden, shown by bold black lines on the map contained in the Order, being that part of footpath No. 42 from the point marked "A" on the map running generally north-eastwards for a distance of 750 ft. to the point marked "E" on the map and thence generally northwards for a distance of 750 ft. to the point marked "B" on the map and that part of footpath No. 43 from the point marked "D" on the map and running generally north-westwards for a distance of approximately 1,230 ft. to the point marked "E" on the map.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the offices of the South Cambridgeshire Rural District Council and may be inspected free of charge at South Cambridgeshire Hall, Hills Road, Cambridge, during normal office hours.

The Order becomes operative as from the date of publication of this notice but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the making of the Order, he may, under section 178 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
