The Secretary of State for the Environment proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968. The effect of the Order will be to amend and extend the existing restrictions relating to the waiting, loading and unloading of vehicles in that kength of the Exeter—Leeds Trunk Road (A.38), which lies partly in the Borough of Bridgwater and partly in the Rural District of Bridgwater, so that:

(1) waiting will be prohibited:

(a) at any time on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 1 and 2 hereto;
(b) between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to

Saturdays inclusive on either of the sides of road specified in Schedule 3 hereto;

(c) between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on the side of road specified in Schedule 4 hereto; fied in Schedule 4 hereto;

(ii) for a longer period than 30 minutes; or
(ii) if a period of less than 30 minutes has
elapsed since the termination during the
said hours of the last period of waiting (if

(2) loading and unloading will be prohibited on any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 1

hereto: (a) between 8.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m.; 12.30 p.m. and 2 p.m.; and 5 p.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in any month and Saturdays between 1st October to 31st May; (b) between 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. on any Saturday between 1st June to 30th September.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle except as in (2) above, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein. Disabled drivers are exempted from the limited waiting restrictions where those restricthe limited waiting restrictions where those restric-
