Captain John Robert HART (473533) The Royal Anglian Regiment

Captain Hart commanded a company in Ballycaptain Hart commanded a company in Bally-murphy, in a hostile environment, for four months. From early January to early February, a period of organised violence, his soldiers were subjected to numerous attacks by shooting, petrol and acid bombs and other missiles. Throughout these operations he displayed outstanding courage and coolness, commanding from the front and frequently exposed to

On 15th January 1971, an agly situation developed and it became necessary to extract search teams. Captain Hart led the rescue operation, personally supervising the withdrawal of nine teams, three of which he brought out himself. His brave, prompt and bold action ensured success in confusing and dangerous circumstances.

Throughout the four months, his leadership and bravery were an inspiration to the officers and men of his company, to which he was a newcomer, and earned their total respect, affection and support.

Captain (Acting) David Lloyd Roberts (481854) The Parachute Regiment

Captain Roberts commanded a platoon in Belfast for a total of twelve months. On 24th January this year, after two nights of arson and violence, he brought a dangerous situation to an end by out-flanking and surprising a mob of 300, who were hurling bottles and bricks at the police, and making

On 26th February 1971, a mob of 300 were engaged in sporadic shooting and hurling gelignite and petrol bombs. Captain Roberts led a baton charge into them and made 17 arrests. Again, on 13th April, 1971, against overwhelming odds, he led his platoon into a crowd of 2,000 trying to burn a Catholic church with throwing bridge petrol heads and captage religious. and throwing bricks, petrol bombs and some gelignite bombs. The platoon made 15 arrests and by his decisive action Captain Roberts assisted in dispersing the mob and preventing further trouble.

Captain Roberts's courage and outstanding leadership on these and many other occasions were an inspiration to the whole battalion.

Captain Murray Forrest STEWART (472626) Royal Army Ordnance Corps

Captain Stewart, an ammunition technical officer, on 9th April 1971, spent an hour in conditions of great danger dismantling a complex system of six gelignite charges, totalling 60 lbs. in the transformer house of a cement factory at Cookstown, Co. Tyrone.

The charges were linked by detonating cord to a firing mechanism activated by an alarm clock delay. The clock had stopped 45 minutes before the firing time, and when Captain Stewart isolated it from the circuit it started again. He checked for secondary means of detonation and found an antihandling device on one charge. After cutting the detonating cord between the charges, he carried five from the building and then returnd to deal with the one with the anti-handling device, successfully cutting out the detonator. cutting out the detonator.

Working meticulously and without regard to his personal danger, Captain Stewart showed courage and skill in dealing with a well-prepared attempt to destroy an important installation which, had it succeeded, would have stopped production at the factory for four months.

The actions of this young officer were an excellent example of the cool, determined courage which has brought great credit to himself and his Corps.

2324440 Warrant Officer Class I (now Captain) Richard Herbert POOLE, Corps of Royal Military Police

During more than eight months in Northern Ireland, Regimental Sergeant-Major Poole set a splendid example to soldiers, police and civilians alike. On 27th June 1970, he exposed himself to great

danger in a clash between rival factions which resulted in the death of several persons. Unarmed and unprotected except by a steel helmet, which was dented during the action, he made several arrests and assisted in others.

On 28th September 1970, during serious rioting, he saw a vicious crowd attacking two Royal Marines. One Marine had been kicked and beaten unconscious; One Marine had been kicked and beaten unconscious; the other had his back to a wall fighting to retain his rifle. Though he risked being shot if they obtained the rifle, R.S.M. Poole ran alone into the mob, dragged them off the Marine with the rifle and, standing astride the unconscious man, held off the attackers with his pistol until help arrived. There is no doubt that he saved the men from grave

injury.

Throughout the period he exerted a steadying effect wherever he appeared and by his bold and courageous action averted clashes on numerous

occasions.

24101868 Private Dorian Stephen Bennett, Royal Regiment of Wales.

During rioting in the Falls Road area of Belfast in the early hours of 8th February this year, Private in the early hours of 8th February this year, Private Bennett and four companions left their armoured vehicle after two rail bombs had been thrown at it. Bennett fired at and gave chase to a man who tried to throw a grenade. The patrol came under fire from three men and Bennett fell with a bullet in his right arm. He regained his feet and engaged the attrackers, hitting one man and possibly a second, and then returned to the rest of the patrol. Although badly affected by the wound, Bennett engaged a further group who attacked with firearms and nail bombs and is thought to have hit one of them. He remained with the patrol until a replacement arrived and only then agreed to go back for medical arrived and only then agreed to go back for medical attention.

By his courageous example and prompt action, Private Bennett saved his patrol from further casualties and his refusal to retire for medical aid ensured that the patrol was not weakened at a critical time. Throughout the action, he showed initiative, courage and devotion to his comrades and to his duty to a high degree.

The Queen has been graciously pleased to approve the award of the British Empire Medal for Gallantry (Military Division) to the undermentioned:

23898645 Staff Sergeant (Acting) Michael Francis Nugent, The Royal Anglian Regiment.

During four months in Belfast, Staff Sergeant (then Sergeant) Nugent formed and commanded six snatch squads, each of twelve men in two vehicles, which were responsible for 170 of the 198 arrests made by the battalion, and several times prevented the escalation of rioting.

An action on 14th January this year was typical of many he led personally. In Ballymurphy two barricades set on fire by riotters were suspected as being part of a ruse to draw troops into an ambush. Sergeant Nugent mounted a move to take the crowd

Sergeant Nugent mounted a move to take the crowd from four directions and himself went forward to act as a decoy. His counter-ruse worked, five arrests were made and the mob was dispersed, though Sergeant Nugent was badly burned by a direct hit from a petrol bomb and narrowly missed injury by a man with an axe.

Sergeant Nugent's consistent bravery and inspiring leadership, in the face of danger from firearms and bombs and other missiles, were in the very best traditions of the service.

24154237 Private David Alan BENNETT, The Queen's Regiment.

On 5th February 1971, Private Bennett was member of a section guard in the Ardoyne district of

Belfast, in a position subjected to stoning by rival factions. During the night, the guard was faced by a crowd of about 100 and for ninety minutes, was the target for nail bombs, pistol and rifle shots and automatic fire from less than 60 yards. Throughout the engagement, Bennett kept cool and, on own initiative, tried to set up a position from which

own initiative, tried to set up a position from which to engage the gunmen.

On the following day, Private Bennett was in an observation post in the Old Ardoyne. At midnight, he came under fire from four gunmen using a machine gun, two rifles and a pistol. Thirty shots hit his sandbagged post over a 90-minute period and another 30 hit the building nearby. Throughout the engagement, Bennett accurately reported the gunmen's positions to his company headquarters and frequently had to expose himself in order to observe them.

Private Bennett's conduct and fearless devotion to duty during both incidents were a tremendous example to his comrades.

In the Ardoyne, Belfast, on 26th February this year, Second Lieutenant Dallas commanded a platoon which came under fire by automatic and other weapons from at least five points. Several soldiers were hit. His men took up fire positions and he himself set off to locate the gunmen. During a burst of fire he spotted a man with an automatic weapon about 50 yards away and engaged him with his pistol, hitting him with the fourth shot. He also gave fire orders to two of his men which resulted in two more gunmen being hit. The action ended when the platoon was reinforced.

Throughout, Second Lieutenant Dallas acted calmly, quickly and resolutely to prevent further casualties to his platoon and to contain an ugly situation. His disregard for his own safety and his fine leadership were an inspiration to his men.

22977759 Warrant Officer Class II Malcolm Ray Hammonds, The Parachute Regiment.

Company Sergeant-Major Hammonds showed outstanding leadership and performed several acts of gallantry during eight months in Belfast. On one occasion, on 4th February this year, he repeatedly led baton charges into a crowd of 200 rioters and continued despite gashes in his leg. On the following day, despite his leg injuries, he again led arrest teams in the face of petrol, gelignite and nail bombs and killed one of the bombers. His skill, fearless example and prompt leadership routed the mob and saved life and limb among his own detachment.

23505403 Sergeant James Walmsley, The Parachute

Sergeant Walmsley displayed distinguished conduct during two riots in the Ardoyne, Belfast. On 5th February 1971, as his platoon de-bussed close to a violent crowd, the leading vehicle was destroyed by gelignite and petrol bombs. Under fire, Sergeant Walmsley organised his troops and shot at and hit a men shout to throw earther bomb. The crowd then man about to throw another bomb. The crowd then retired.

On 11th February, when in charge of a foot patrol, he ordered a man carrying a long parcel to hakt. The man dropped the parcel, which contained a rifle, and fled. Sergeant Walmsley, though in a dangerous area, set off in pursuit and, after a long chase, arrested him.

23883534 Sergeant Andrew Robb Welsh, The Parachute Regiment.

Sergeant Welsh displayed bravery and cool leadersergeant weish displayed bravery and cool leader-ship on three occasions while commanding a platoon in Belfast. On one of them, on the night of 13th-14th April this year, he was hit by a gelignite bomb which also injured some of his men. Undeterred he rallied the squad and pursued the bomber. In all, Sergeant Welsh was instrumental in making 50 arrests in the three actions, in two of which he and his men-were subjected to bomb attacks, and in restoring order from dangerous situations.
