ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

ALDERSHOT BOROUGH COUNCIL

Borough of Aldershot (Church Road and Park Road) (Restriction and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1971.

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Aldershot propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2), (3) and (6) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

When this Order comes into force you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle within approximately 60 feet of the junction of Park Road and Church Road (in all directions).

Exceptions are provided for (a) the picking up and setting down of passengers and where necessary, in connection with

- (b) the maintenance of the roads;
- (c) the supply of gas, electricity and water.

Further you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle between 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on the east side of Church Road between points 144 feet and 488 feet north of Lower Farnham Road (loading/unloading will be allowed).
