BIRKENHEAD COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Birkenhead (Brook Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1971

Notice is hereby given that on the 28th day of October 1971, the Birkenhead County Borough Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on:

Brook Street from its termination in an easterly direction for a distance of 23 metres in a westerly direction.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to permit waiting for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading or unloading and for funerals, building and road works and the maintenance of essential services.

A copy of the Order, together with a map showing the lengths of road concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be examined at the Town Hall, Birkenhead, during normal office hours.

This Order will come into operation on the 6th day of December 1971.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 5th November 1971, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The City of Birmingham (Ley Hill Farm Road and Rhayader Road) (One-Way Traffic) Order, 1971

The City of Birmingham (Addison Road, etc.) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1971

The City of Birmingham (Heath Mill Lane, etc.) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1971

Notice is hereby given that the Lord Mayor, Aldermen and citizens of the city of Birmingham propose to make Orders under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be as follows:

The City of Birmingham (Ley Hill Farm Road and Rhayader Road) (One-Way Traffic) Order, 1971.

To introduce one-way traffic in the under-mentioned lengths of road in the direction specified opposite to those lengths of road:

The City of Birmingham (Addison Road, etc.) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1971.

(a) To introduce no waiting at any time in parts of the under-mentioned roads in the City:

Addison Road, Goldsmith Road, Melton Road, Gaddesby Road, Springfield Road, Brook Lane, Barn Lane, Portman Road, Vicarage Road Old Carriageway.

(b) To introduce no waiting on Monday to Saturday between 7.30 a.m. and 1 p.m. and to permit waiting for one hour in two between 1 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. in further parts of Addison Road aforesaid.

(c) To introduce no waiting on Monday to Saturday between 1 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. and to permit waiting for one hour in two between 7.30 a.m. and 1 p.m. in further parts of Addison Road aforesaid.

(d) To permit waiting for one hour in two on Monday to Saturday between 7.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. in part of Vicarage Road Old Carriageway aforesaid.

This Order contains an exemption in respect of the loading and unloading of goods in all the lengths of road set out above.

The City of Birmingham (Heath Mill Lane, etc.) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1971.

(a) To introduce no waiting at any time in parts of the undermentioned roads in the City:

Heath Mill Lane, Gibb Street, Lower Trinity Street.

(b) To introduce no waiting on Monday to Saturday between 7.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. in further parts of Heath Mill Lane and Gibb Street aforesaid.

This Order contains an exemption in respect of the loading and unloading of goods in all the lengths of road set out above.

The City of Birmingham (Harborne Road, etc.) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1971.

(a) To introduce no waiting at any time in parts of the under-mentioned roads in the City:

Harborne Road, Highfield Road, Vicarage Road.

(b) To introduce no waiting on Monday to Saturday between 7.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. in further parts of Vicarage Road and Highfield Road aforesaid.

(c) To introduce no waiting on Monday to Friday between 7.30 a.m. and 1 p.m. in a further part of Harborne Road aforesaid.

(d) To introduce no waiting on Monday to Friday between 1 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. in a further part of Harborne Road aforesaid.

This Order contains an exemption in respect of the loading and unloading of goods in all the lengths of road set out above.

The City of Birmingham (George Road, Erdington) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment) Order, 1971.

To amend the City of Birmingham (Traffic Regulation) (No. 25) Order, 1970, so that the existing prohibition on waiting at any time at the junction in the City of George Road with Slade Road will be extended for an additional 45 yards along the north side, and for an additional 29 yards along the south side, of George Road.

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Orders, which together with maps and statements of the Council's reasons for the proposals, may be examined at the office of the undersigned and at the offices of the City Engineer, Surveyor and Planning Officer, Highways and Transportation Division, 3rd Floor, Baskerville House, Birmingham, during normal office hours.
