Notice is hereby given that the above Order, made on the 28th day of October 1971, is about to be submitted to the Department of the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed, as an unopposed Order, by the Sevenoaks Rural District Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert that part of public footpath No. 405 in the Parish of Leigh commencing on the western boundary of Field O.S. 9142 to the north-west of Coppings Farm and south of Coppings Gill and running south-east across O.S. 9142 through Coppings Farm to the south-west corner of Field O.S. 1300 then south-west across Field O.S. 0005 to the west side of the boundary pond and then south across Field O.S. 0179 for a total distance of 2910 feet to its junction with Coppings Road between Nos. 2 and 3 Coppings Brook Cottages; that part of public footpath No. 406 commencing at its junction with public footpath No. 405 immediately north of Coppings Farm and running in a north-easterly direction across Field O.S. 1719 for a distance of 625 feet to the point where the path turns to the south-east near the north-eastern boundary of O.S. 1719; and that part of public footpath No. 407 commencing at the south-western corner of Field O.S. 8900 to the east of Wickhurst Farm Cottages and running in a north-easterly direction along or near the southern boundaries of Fields O.S. 8900 and O.S. 9800 for a distance of 625 feet to its junction with public footpath No. 405 south of
