A Notice not signed by all the Partners named therein or their legal representatives must be accompanied by a Statutory Declaration made by a Solicitor of the Supreme Court to the effect that such Notice is given in pursuance of the terms of the partnership to which it relates.

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Advertisements of Changes of Names will not be inserted unless:

- (a) they are signed or attested by a Solicitor of the Supreme Court, or
- (b) the Praecipe relating to the advertisement is produced for inspection at the time the advertisement is submitted, or
- (c) a duplicate Praecipe relating to the advertisement is produced for retention by The London Gazette Office.

Advertisements relating to Bills before Parliament will not be inserted unless signed a by Parliamentary Agent or a Solicitor of the Supreme Court.
