The Trunk Road (High Street and Great North Road, Gosforth) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1971.

The Secretary of State for the Environment has made an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

The Order prohibits loading and unloading at all times (where waiting is now prohibited) for the following sides of High Street in the Urban District of Gosforth in the county of Northumberland:

- East side, extending from 56 yards south of its junction with St. Nicholas Avenue to 31 yards south of that junction; and
- West side, extending from 83 yards south of its junction with St. Nicholas Avenue to 43 yards south of that junction.

Exceptions have been provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

The Trunk Road (London Road, Waterlooville) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1971.

The Secretary of State for the Environment proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D

poses to make an Order under sections I and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to extend the existing prohibition on waiting of vehicles in the London—Portsmouth Trunk Road (A.3), known as London Road, Waterlooville in the Urban District of Havant and Waterloo, Hampshire. The restrictions in London Road will then be as follows:

- (1) No Waiting at any time
 - (a) east side, from its junction with Beaconsfield Road to its junction with Hulbert Road (B.2150);
 - (b) east side, from a point 86 yards north of its junction with Hambledon Road (B.2150) to a point 98 yards south of its junction with Stakes Hill Road;
 - (c) west side, from a point 132 yards south of its junction with Winifred Road to a point 100 yards north of its junction with Hambledon Road (B.2150).
- (2) No Waiting and Loading/Unloading at any time
 - (a) east side, from its junction with Hulbert Road to a point 86 yards north of its junction with Hambledon Road (B.2150);
 - (b) west side, from a point 100 yards north of its junction with Hambledon Road (B.2150) to its junction with Forest End.
- (3) Waiting for more than 30 minutes prohibited

and no return within 30 minutes

East side, from a point 98 yards south of its junction with Stakes Hill Road to a point 6 yards north of its junction with Forest End.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle except as specified in paragraph 2 (2) above, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.
