LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Leicestershire County Council (Various Roads, Market Bosworth) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1971.

Notice is hereby given that the Leicestershire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which will be to:

- (a) prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times on the side and lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice; and
