

River; thence southwards behind the building line abutting the west bank of Three Mills Wall River for a distance of approximately 220 metres; thence westwards through buildings and extending riverwards to the centre of the River Lea at a point at the northern extremity of Empress Wharf; thence

southwards along the centre of that River (being the borough boundary) to the District Line railway.
