

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The Trunk Road (Owen Road, Lancaster)
(Prohibition of Entry) Order, 1972

The Secretary of State for the Environment proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

The effect of the Order will be to make permanent the existing experimental prohibition which prohibits vehicles proceeding in the London—Carlisle—Glasgow—Inverness Trunk Road (A.6) known as Owen Road in the city of Lancaster, to enter Old Owen Road in the said city.
