ST. HELENS COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The St. Helens (Waterloo Street) Traffic Order 1971

Notice is hereby given that the St. Helens County Borough Council have on the 16th November 1971, made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which is to revoke some of the provisions of the County Borough of St. Helens (Various Streets) (Traffic Regulation) No. 2 Order 1968, and to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times on the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

The Order contains the usual exemptions for boarding and alighting from vehicles, loading and unloading of goods, building operations, road maintenance, etc., and for Post Office and funeral vehicles.

A copy of the Order, which will come into effect on the 1st December 1971, and map showing the length of road affected together with a Statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be seen at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, St. Helens, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the 16th November 1971, the date of making of the Order, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

ST. HELENS COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The St. Helens (Duncan Street Passageway) (Weight Restriction) Order, 1971

Notice is hereby given that the St. Helens County Borough Council have on the 16th November 1971, made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle the unladen weight of which exceeds thirty hundredweights to proceed in the lengths of passageway specified in the Schedule to this Order. The Order contains exemptions relating to the gaining of access for persons or goods to any premises situated on or adjacent to those lengths of passageway and the carrying out of building operations, demolition, road maintenance, the removal of obstructions to traffic and the installation or maintenance of statutory undertakings etc.

A copy of the Order, which will come into effect on the 1st February 1972, and map showing the lengths of passageway affected together with a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be seen at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, St. Helens, during normal office hours.

SOUTHEND-ON-SEA COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

County Borough of Southend-on-Sea (Hobleythick Lane—Waiting Bay) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1971.

Notice is hereby given that the Southend-on-Sea County Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 the effect of which will be as follows:

(a) It will permit vehicles to wait for one hour in any four hours in the following length of road:

Hobleythick Lane from a point five yards north of its junction with Mayfield Avenue to the northern extremity of the waiting bay fronting Numbers 126-138 Hobleythick Lane.	East.

(b) It will revoke so much of the County Borough of Southend-on-Sea (Hobleythick Lane) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1969 as is inconsistent with the above proposals.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for a person to board or alight to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle or to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of furniture or of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

A copy of the proposed Order, a map showing the road to which the Order relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at my office at the Civic Centre, Victoria Avenue, during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposals together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent, in writing, to me by the 16th December 1971.
