Vehicles will be exempt from the prohibitions in (4) for as long as may be necessary:
(a) for fire, police or ambulance purposes on an emergency call.
(b) as a pedestrian controlled vehicle.
(c) as a public utility or local authority vehicle for street works.
(d) by a funeral undertaker.
(e) as an invalid carriage.
(f) with the permission of a Police Constable or Traffic Warden in uniform.
( $g$ ) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle.
( $h$ ) when being used for building, engineering or street maintenance operations.
(i) when being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
(j) when being used by the Post Office for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets.
( $k$ ) when used by a disabled person and issued by the Department of Health and Social Security in lieu of an invalid carriage
(l) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle for no longer period than 20 minutes.
(5) To prohibit vehicles from waiting 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, with a peak hour loading ban Monday to Saturday, in the roads or lengths of roads as specified in Schedule V.


Vehicles will be exempt from the prohibitions in (5) for as long as may be necessary:
(A) to enable a vehicle to be used for any of the purposes specified in $4(a),(b),(c),(d),(e),(f),(g),(h),(i)$, ( $j$ ), (k).
B) for the purpose of loading or unloading goods for a period of no longer than 20 minutes, except between the hours of 8-9.30 a.m., 12.30-2 p.m. and 4.30-6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive.
(6) To prohibit vehicles from waiting between 8 a.m. -6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive, with a peak hour loading ban in the lengths of road specified in Schedule VI.
