22674586 Warrant Officer Class I John Samuel WOOD, Corps of Royal Military Police.

Within a few days of his arrival in Northern Ireland in July last year Warrant Officer Class I Wood, of the Corps of Royal Military Police, was detailed for duty during operations in the Lower Falls area of Belfast. Heedless of danger, he carried out his military duties with great courage and detarmination determination.

Subsequently, after the severe Shankill riots in September, 1970, and again in January 1971, he was able to bring a number of difficult and important military police matters to a successful conclusion.

During his period of service in Northern Ireland W.O. Wood has never flinched from work under fire or from entering areas where his life could have been in danger, and has set a splendid example of sustained courage and resolution which deserves the highest recognition.

The QUEEN has been graciously pleased to approve the award of the British Empire Medal for Gallantry (Military Division) to the undermentioned :

23710955 Sergeant Islay Christopher John Menzies CARRIER, Royal Army Ordnance Corps.

In three months in Northern Ireland, Sergeant Carrier dealt with more than 120 explosive devices. On one occasion he encountered a bomb of a new type and, rather than explode it where it lay, he decided to dismantle it for the benefit of colleagues who might have to deal with similar bombs. It was fitted with an anti-handling device and would have ntted with an anti-handling device and would have exploded at the slightest movement but Sergeant Carrier, disregarding his own safety, took 30 minutes to strip it down. During the next three days he dealt similarly with two other bombs fitted with different anti-handling devices. From these three bombs, Sergeant Carrier obtained involve he information about the construction of the

invaluable information about the construction of the deadly devices. In doing so he was always in a great danger. In all his actions, he displayed extreme skill and his cool manner was an inspiration to all.

23921377 Sergeant Robert Leo LOCKWOOD, Royal Army Ordnance Corps.

During a four month period in Northern Ireland earlier this year, Sergeant Lockwood personally dealt with 148 terrorist explosive devices of varying ingenuity, 14 of them on one day. In many instances he faced hostility from the mob as well as danger from unexploded bombs and was often struck by missiles missiles.

missiles. Throughout he maintained the highest state of coolness and concentration which enabled him to deal efficiently with every device encountered and he was always concerned for the safety of others: he ensured the danger area was cleared of all per-sonnel save himself. At all times he displayed great personal courage and never hesitated to tackle bombs he knew could explode at any time.

he knew could explode at any time. In his task he endeared himself to officers and men of every branch of the Service by his cheer-fulness, humour and selfless disregard for his own safety. Never did he allow himself to be discouraged by the events occurring around him.

23682835 Warrant Officer Class II (acting) Terence Colin PARK, Royal Army Ordnance Corps.

Warrant Officer Park dealt with more than 100 explosive devices during four months in Northern Ireland and on several occasions was struck by missiles

while disarming devices during riots. On 29th January, he found that a delayed action incendiary bomb had been placed in the back of an Army vehicle. On 29th Recognising the peril to the driver, he ordered the area to be cleared and lifted the bomb from the vehicle. The device immediately burst into flames but he was able to throw it into the now empty roadway where it burnt out. His brave and timely action prevented severe injuries, possibly loss of life, and Warrant Officer Park throughout his tour displayed

courage and devotion to duty far beyond the normal call in handling large quantities of explosives of doubtful stability and with dangerous devices.

23505980 Sergeant Peter WALLACE, The Royal Highland Fusiliers.

Sergeant Wallace commanded a three-man mobile Sergeant Wallace commanded a unree-man moone patrol which investigated a suspicious car in Academy Street, Belfast, on 15th May this year. Bursts of machine-gun fire from the car wounded his radio-operator and driver and then the gunmen fied. Sergeant Wallace returned the fire and hit two of the gunger one fall and the other two escaped in a

Sergeant Wallace returned the nre and nit two or the gunmen; one fell and the other two escaped in a maze of alleyways. While he was investigating the condition of the wounded gunman he had to deal with a hostile crowd until assistance arrived. His prompt action and bravery undoubtedly prevented these gunmen from making further attacks that night.

The QUEEN has been graciously pleased to approve the award of The Queen's Commendation for Brave Conduct to the undermentioned:

(now Major) Edward Michael EDWARDS Captain (467340), The Parachute Regiment.

From mid-February to early June this year. Maior Edwards reimposed the authority of the Security Forces in an area of Belfast where riots, bombings, sniping and ambushes had become frequent. He led a large number of patrols into the terrorists' area with a large humber of pairols and the terrorists area with considerable success. On 5th March his company position was attacked for an hour by small arms fire and with disregard for his own safety, Major Edwards moved about to observe and identify the gunmen's position and ordered a sniper to return the fire. His resolute action enabled him to keep a firm-prin on a deparence situation which enders and the rip on a dangerous situation which endangered the lives of innocent persons. Later, when two of his patrols were ambushed, he was relentless in his follow-up action which he directed personally. Throughout his tour, he conducted his operations with courage, resolute leadership and skilful diplomacy.

24141971 Guardsman William Anthony MORRIS, Welsh Guards.

On 3rd July in Belfast terrorists attacked Guards-man Morris's sentry post in Malone Road with two sub-machine guns and nail bombs. He returned fire and was then hurled to the ground by the explosion of three bombs which, miraculously, did fire and was then hurled to the ground by the explosion of three bombs which, miraculously, did not injure him. The young guardsman picked him-self up and, still under heavy fire, continued to engage the terrorists until they fled, abandoning five nail bombs.

By his coolness and courage under intense fire, Guardsman Morris singlehanded thwarted a determined and well planned terrorist attack.

23971837 Corporal David John SMITH, Corps of Royal Military Police.

Corporal Smith was involved in peace-keeping in Northern Ireland for almost two years until July 1971. During the spring and summer of 1970, as driver and radio operator for the officer in charge of military police in Belfast, he drove his unprotected vehicles through the most violent crowds and his coolness and daring became by-words. On some occasions he alone talked potentially hostile groups

occasions he alone talked potentially nostile groups into dispersing. He faced violent mobs day after day and endured long periods without rest that would have broken a lesser man. He returned to a platoon in August 1970 and his steadfastness, courage and determination were an inspiration to all. As an assistant in the operations room from March 1971, his intelligent and quick reactions enabled many potentially dangerous situations to be dealt with successfully. His contri-bution to peace-keeping over the whole period was bution to peace-keeping over the whole period was remarkable.

23167652 Staff Sergeant Thomas McIvor WATT, Corps of Royal Military Police.

Between March 1970 and July this year, Staff Sergeant Watt commanded a platoon in a peace-keeping role in Northern Ireland. Although unarmed and without protective clothing he was always to the forefront in riot situations, supervising patrols and dealing with hooligans. His sense of anticipation, coolness and determination averted many sectarian clashes which could have become serious sectarian clashes which could have become serious riots.

He came under attack from stones, clubs, firearms and explosives a number of times and on one occasion suffered a severe head injury while rescuing a soldier from a mob. Throughout his tour, Staff Sergeant Watt never once hesitated in the face of danger and he set examples of steadiness, professional skill and leader-bin above the ordinary
