The Brighton Corporation (Various Roads—Rottingdean) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting)
 Order 1972

Notice is hereby given that the Brighton County Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1), (2) and (3) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968: the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting:

- (i) at all times in the lengths of road described in the first column of Schedule 1 to this Notice on the side or sides of road described opposite such length in the second column of that Schedule;
- (ii) between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day except Sundays in the lengths of road described in the first column of Schedule 2 to this Notice on the side of road described opposite such length in the second column of that Schedule; and
- (iii) between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day except Saturdays and Sundays on the west side of the western carriageway of the Green, Rottingdean, from 20 feet north of High Street northwards for 90 feet.

and to limit waiting to one hour in any two hours, between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day except Sundays in the lengths of road described in the first column of Schedule 3 to this Notice on the side or sides of road described opposite such length in the second column of that Schedule.

The proposed Order will contain the usual provisions permitting vehicles to wait for persons to board or alight or goods to be loaded or unloaded or, if it is a Post Office vehicle for delivering or collecting postal packets; to enable the vehicle to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic or the maintenance of the roads or the services therein or in connection with bill posting, window cleaning or chimney sweeping.

A vehicle displaying a disabled persons badge may be left in any of the lengths of road described in the first column of Schedule 3 to this Notice on the side or sides of road described opposite such length in the second column of that Schedule, beyond the maximum waiting period without penalty.

A copy of the proposed Order, a map showing the roads affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the Enquiry Office at the Town Hall, Brighton, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays and between 9 a.m. and noon on Saturdays.
