signalled forward No. 2 who also made a perfect exit. Immediately No. 2 had left the aircraft Flight Sergeant Allen felt a knock on his right knee and saw Sergeant Allen felt a knock on his right knee and saw the monorail, which had become detached from the fuselage, sliding fast out of the open door. He immediately leant forward and caught it with both hands. At the same time the slipstream caught the static line of the first parachute which was still, together with the inner bag, connected to the mono-rail, and sucked it out of the aircraft. The pull on the monorail increased to such a degree that Flight Sergeant Allen was in danger of being pulled out of the aircraft himself although he did not let go with either hand. It soon became obvious that there were more than just two bags trailing in the slipstream. In fact the No. 2 was "hung up" and Flight Sergeant Allen had to wedge his body in the doorway and exert considerable strength to prevent the other four parachutists and himself being pulled from the air-craft as they were all attached to the monorail. After a short time, during which he saw the "hung up" parachute deploy, the strain eased and he managed to recover both bags and the monorail. The heli-copter then landed. Flight Sergeant Allen's quick thinking, immediate bold action and outstanding initi-ative undoubtedly resulted in the saving of the lives of the parachutists and the possible loss of the aircraft and all in it. If he had not caught and held the monorail the resulting effects would have led to a disaster. the monorail, which had become detached from the disaster.
