Queen's Commendation for Brave Conduct 22543716 Warrant Officer Class II Anthony HILL, Royal Engineers.

Warrant Officer Class II Hill of 35 Engineer Regiment Royal Engineers was employed as a member of the Safety Organisation at Wispenstein bridge, Germany, during a Divisional exercise.

At about 0005 hours on 29th September 1971 a

N.C.O. who was the radio operator and driver to the umpire on the bridge adjusted his 27-foot radio mast. The aerial struck an overhead power cable and the flash and muffled scream attracted Warrant and the flash and muffled scream attracted Warrant Officer Hill to the scene. Seeing the N.C.O. rigid and clutching the mast, and with smoke pouring from the vehicle, he hurled himself at the N.C.O. and hit him with both hands about chest high. The impetus broke the N.C.O.'s hold on the mast and the shock threw Warrant Officer Hill against a parked vehicle. He then dragged the N.C.O. clear of the mast and coaxial lead and attempted to give first aid by heart

coaxial lead and attemptd to give first aid by heart massage and mouth-to-mouth resuscitation. The latter was made difficult as Warrant Officer Hill was unable to unclench the N.C.O.'s jaw. Warrant Officer Hill continued to work on the patient until the arrival of

medical help.
Warrant Officer Hill did all in his power to save the N.C.O.'s life and his brave action, when he knew very well in what danger he personally was in, brought credit not only to his Corps, but also to the British Army.
