PRESENT

THE QUEEN'S Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act 1865, c. 73 and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Hrs Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Pay and Allowances) (Third Amendment) Order 1971.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1889, c. 63 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

General

3. In the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Pay and Allowances) Order 1970, Schedule 5 (which deals with Education Grants for University, Medical and Dental Cadets) shall cease to have effect from 1st January 1972; and from that date Schedule 1 to this Order shall apply in its place.

4. In the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Pay and Allowances) (Second Amendment) Order 1971, paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 (which deals with the pay of Royal Naval General and Supplementary Lists and Instructor Officers) shall cease to have effect from 1st January 1972; and from that date Schedule 2 to this Order shall apply in its place.

SCHEDULE 1

University, Medical and Dental Cadets

1. Officers entered as University Cadets shall when at University or while undertaking acquaint or vocational training during their degree course have included in their pay an Education Grant of £1.44 a day.

2. Surgeon Sub-Lieutenants and Surgeon Sub-Lieutenants (D) shall have included in their pay an Education Grant of £2.35 a day.

3. The Education Grants referred to in this Schedule shall be recoverable in such circumstances as may be laid down in rules made by the Defence Council or by the Admiralty Board on their behalf.
